### **ANNUAL SCHOOL REPORT (SESSION 2025–2026)**

#### **Scholastic Achievements**

Academic achievements reflect the diligence and skills of students striving to perform to the best of their abilities. The fourth batch of Class X and the third batch of Class XII students successfully completed their practical examinations and are currently appearing for the CBSE Board Theory Examinations 2026. The sincere efforts of both students and teachers have brought laurels to the school.

The Annual Examinations for the session 2025–2026 were conducted from **25th February 2026 to 16th March 2026**. Periodic Assessments I & II, Half-Yearly Exams, and two Pre-Board Examinations were conducted as per schedule.

The results will be declared as follows:

- **27th March 2026:** Nursery to Prep
- **28th March 2026:** Classes I to V
- **30th March 2026:** Classes VI to IX & XI

A variety of educational and club activities were organized throughout the year in accordance with CBSE guidelines and the school calendar. Spoken English and remedial classes were conducted to enhance students' learning levels. Students also participated in online courses on Artificial Intelligence and Coding. Career guidance programmes were organized for Classes XI and XII.

National festivals were celebrated with enthusiasm through cultural programmes, competitions, and activities like Prabhat Pheri.

#### **Summer Camp 2025**

The Summer Camp was organized from **22nd May to 31st May 2025**, making the vacation period productive and enjoyable. Activities included Guitar, Keyboard, Zumba, Dance, Yoga, Spoken English, Personality Development, Debate, Talk Shows, and special Mathematics classes for Class XII students. Students also engaged in outdoor games like Volleyball, Badminton, Kho-Kho, and indoor games such as Chess and Carrom. The camp was both enjoyable and skill-enhancing.

#### **Excursion & Educational Tours**

An excursion to **Mukundpur White Tiger Safari, Rewa (M.P.)** was organized on **7th November 2025**, with 56 students participating under staff supervision. Students explored the safari, Bird Aviary, and Eco Park, gaining knowledge about wildlife and nature.

An educational tour to the **Geophysics Centre, Jhansi, Prayagraj** was conducted on **5th December 2025** for Classes VIII to XII. Students learned about the Earth's structure, core, earthquakes, and geophysical phenomena, enhancing their scientific understanding.

#### **Co-Curricular & Student Development**

- **Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTM):** Conducted regularly; the last PTM was held in January 2026.

- **Teacher Training:** Teachers attended CBSE training programmes (online & offline) for NEP implementation and modern teaching techniques.
  - **Health Programmes:** Yoga Day was observed, and Albendazole tablets were distributed as per government guidelines.
  - **Counselling:** Regular individual and group counselling sessions were conducted for students.
